DIG DEEPER

In the 1990s, Gary Chapman wrote a best-selling book titled: "The 5 Love Languages." He explained that each person receives and gives love in five different categories: **Gifts, Quality Time, Acts of Service, Words of Affirmation, and Physical Touch.**

As I was preparing for the series we are currently studying on "Love," I asked myself what God's love language is? How does God feel loved? And I found that **1 John 5:1-3** says it very clearly. The way in which God feels loved is not by giving him gifts, it is not by serving him, it is not through our words (although, all these things are good!), but God feels loved simply when we obey him **(1 Samuel 15:22)**.

- 1. What is your love language? If you're married, do you know your partner's?
- 2. Why do you think God delights more in obedience rather than sacrifice?
- 3. How would you read your level of obedience?

Read **Ephesians 3:14-19 (NLT)**, and talk about the <u>mystery</u> of knowing God's love. Paul teaches that it's not something that can be achieved humanly, but through the Spirit.

Pray together for a greater revelation of God's love.
