

TALK IT OVER FAVOR FINDERS

DIG DEEPER

There are two people in the Bible who <u>found</u> God's favor. One was Mary **(Luke 1:30)**, and the other was Noah **(Genesis 6:8)**. Favor is preferential treatment from God, where you obtain an elite status undeservingly. Favor is also tangible evidence of God's approval.

This caught my curiosity, and I began my journey to *"find"* God's favor. It's obvious that if I want to find something, I have to look for that very thing. But I discovered that in order to find God's favor, I need to look for Him! And by finding Him, I find life and receive His favor **(Proverbs 8:35)**. Often, we trade the blessor for the blessing *(Mr. Wonderful would say: horrible deal!)*

REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- 1. Self-Evaluation: How much time do you invest daily in seeking God?
- 2. According to **Psalms 30:5,** is God's favor temporary or does it last? How long?
- 3. What is your greatest obstacle you need to overcome to begin growing in favor?

"For whoever finds me finds life and receives favor from the Lord. - **Proverbs 8:35 (NLT)**

SIMPLICITY

The 4 practical steps to grow in favor (Luke 2:52) are:

- 1. Take your Prayer Life to Another Level (Romans 8:26-27)
- 2. Learn to Listen to God (Psalm 32:8-9)
- 3. Work on your Character (Galatians 5:24)
- 4. Be Consistent and Persevere! (Hebrews 10:24-25 & 35-36)

Encourage participants to make a pact (along with you), to begin practicing these for steps for 30 days. When the 30 days are over, share your results. You'll be amazed! Pray together.
